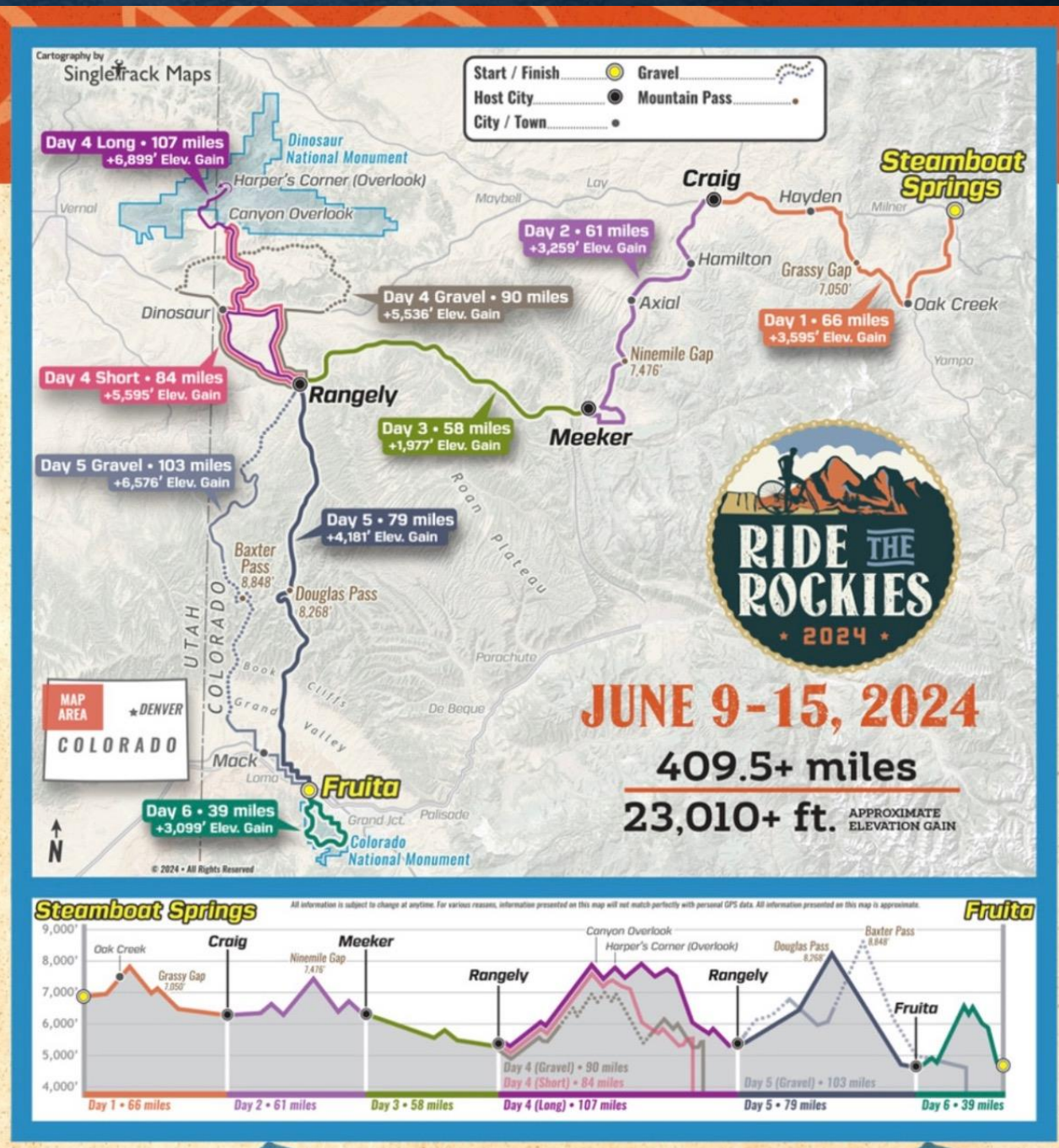



- Riders have a timing chip in their number plate and the uphill portions of the passes will be timed. This also helps staff track cyclists.




Pan-Mass Challenge

Broadmoor Cycle to the Summit (Pike's Peak)

August 10, 2024

- 12.8 miles straight up to the top. Timed. 156 turns. Steep turns. ~6,000'.
- Closed road, however, they want you at the gate of Pike's Peak early (4:30)
- Free shuttle down. If you have rim brakes, do NOT ride down!!
- \$65 with a tech tee. Jersey separate.
- Snacks and one aid station—no adult beverages.



Stonewall Century Ride

August 10, 2024

- 102 miles
- 7500+ feet elevation gain
- Out-and-back ride—turn around whenever you like.
- Ride along CO State Hwy 12 to Segundo and back.
- 7 SAG stations



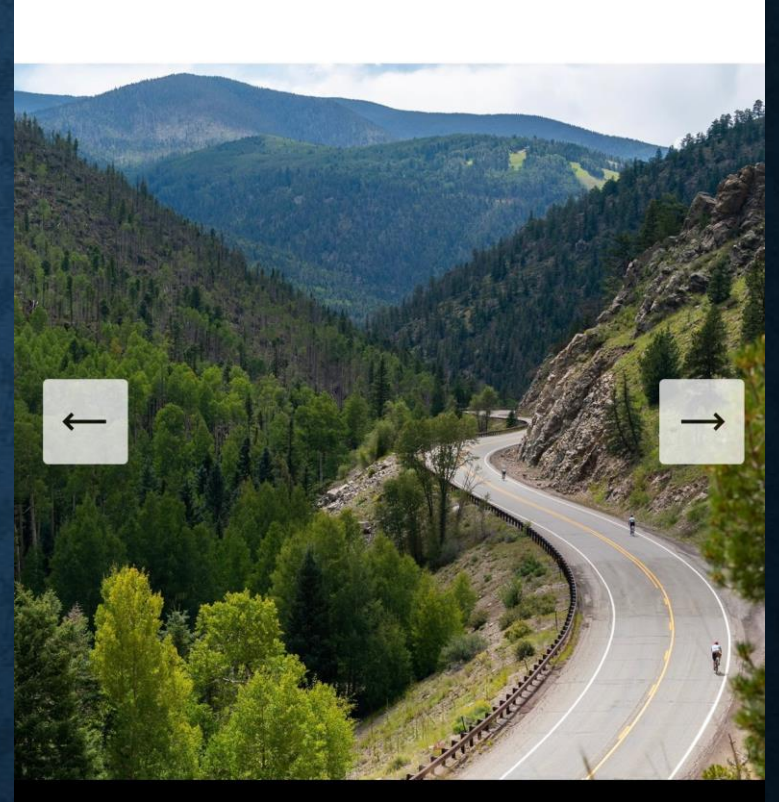
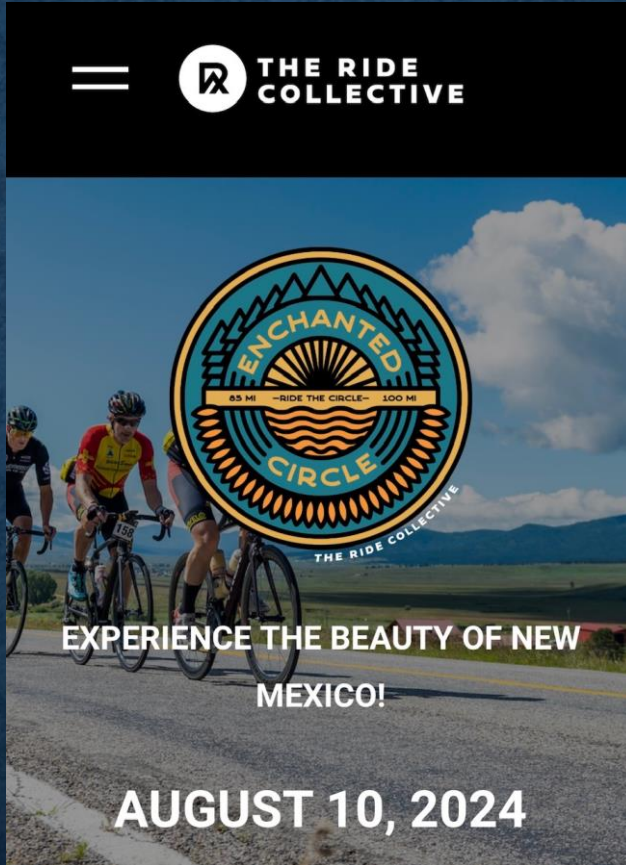

August 10, 2024

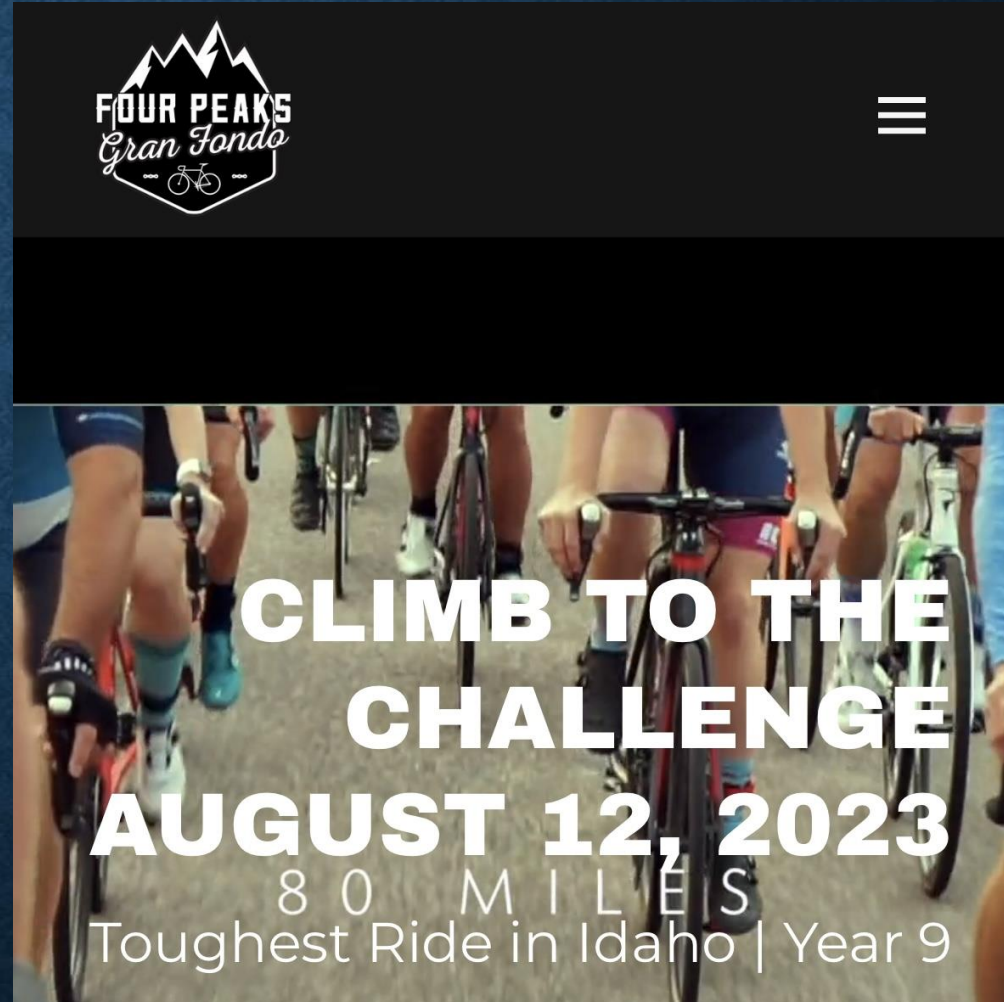
- 85 and 100-mile courses

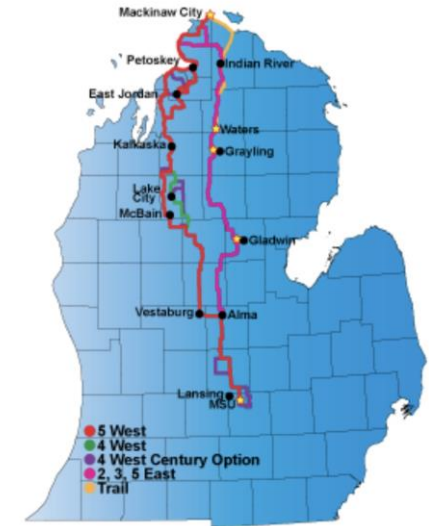

- \$145 (with jersey) and \$125 (tech tee)

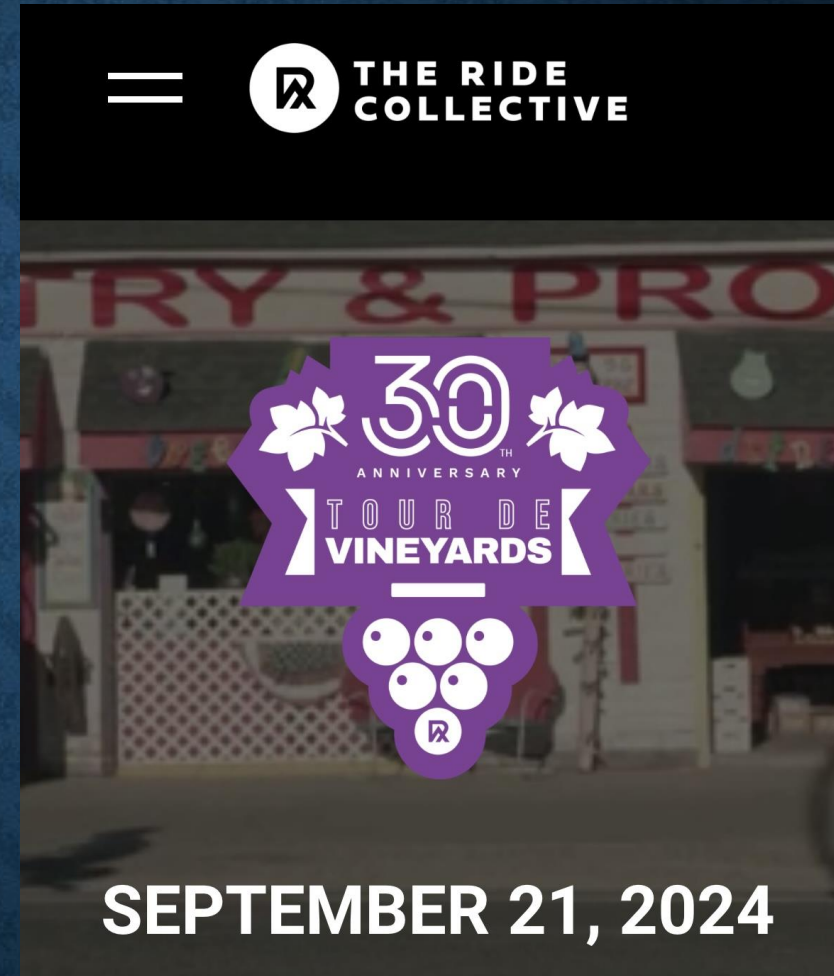

September 28, 2024

- Denver, CO
- 80 miles
- Save 25% now: 50, 85 and 100 mile: \$96...25 mile: \$72 and 25 mile (14 & under): \$51



Buffalo Bicycle Classic

September 8, 2024

- Boulder, CO
- A LOT of ride choices: 14 miles; 35 (“Mary’s Loop”); 50; 70 (Carter Lake); 100 miles.
- EPIC routes (up a closed Boulder canyon): Epic 75 (canyon to Peak-to-Peak highway); Buff Epic 100 miles (Boulder Canyon to Allenspark and down to Lyons).
- Gravel: “Dirty Buff” – 42 miles; Dirty EPIC: 59 miles.
- Group discount: \$15 off, then if we have 10+, another \$15 off for a total of \$30!
